# GARLIC

## Ultra-early varieties

The ultra-early varieties are the first to arrive on the market (fresh or dry), kick-starting sales early in the season.

### From planting to harvest



### AULXITO

exclusive to TOP Semence

#### The earliest white Garlic on the market

- Very white bulb with flower stalk
- White cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Ultra-early
- Very low dormancy



### SPRINT

exclusive to TOP Semence

#### The earliest purple Garlic on the market

- Purple striped bulb with flower stalk
- Pinkish white cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Ultra-early
- Very low dormancy



# GARLIC

## Autumn purples, softneck varieties

Large bulbed distinctly purple autumn varieties. Ideal for selling dry or fresh, offering sales potential early in the season.

### From planting to harvest



## GERMIDOUR

### The earliest purple garlic

- Purple bulb
- Brown-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Very early
- Low dormancy



## VALDOUR

exclusive to TOP Semence

### Slightly later, enabling staggered harvests!

- White striped purple bulb
- Dark beige-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Very early
- Low dormancy



## PARADOUR

### Regular and well-formed!

- Purple striped white bulb
- Brown-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Very early
- Low dormancy





# GARLIC

## Autumn whites, softneck varieties

These are autumn varieties with large white bulbs, typical of the Drôme area.

### From planting to harvest



## TOPADRÔME

exclusive to TOP Semence



**Well-divided variety,  
the least susceptible to Waxy Breakdown**

- White bulb
- Cream-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Early
- Average dormancy



## MESSIDOR

**Large bulb variety, high yielding**

- White bulb
- Cream-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Early
- Average dormancy



## THERMIDRÔME

**Hardy variety**

- White bulb, very low presence of anthocyanins
- Beige-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Early
- Average dormancy



## MESSIDRÔME

**Typical variety of white Garlic  
from the Drôme**

- White bulb
- Cream-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Early
- Average dormancy



# GARLIC

## Hardneck varieties

Flower stalk varieties, with a long shelf-life and very colourful cloves, for staggered harvests and sales.

### From planting to harvest



**VAYO**

exclusive to TOP Semence



#### Distinct purple regular bulb

- Compact purplish white bulb turning a beautiful purple after removal of the outer skins, with a flower stalk
- Purple-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Moderately early
- Average dormancy



**SULTOP**

exclusive to TOP Semence



#### Tarn pink garlic type with very colourful cloves!

- White bulb with a flower stalk
- Dark pink streaked cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus free variety
- Moderately early
- Average to high dormancy





# GARLIC

## Spring pink Garlic

High dormancy varieties, particularly good for long shelf-life. The pink colour often only becomes apparent after separating the cloves.

### From planting to harvest



### VIVALTO

exclusive to TOP Semence



#### The earliest variety in its category!

- White bulb
- Light pink-coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Semi-late
- High dormancy



### CRISTO

exclusive to TOP Semence

#### Mid-season maturity spring Garlic

- White bulb
- Light pink/beige coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Semi-late to late
- High dormancy



### ARNO

exclusive to TOP Semence



#### High yielding variety with the longest shelf-life

- White bulb
- Slightly pink/beige coloured cloves
- Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Late
- High dormancy

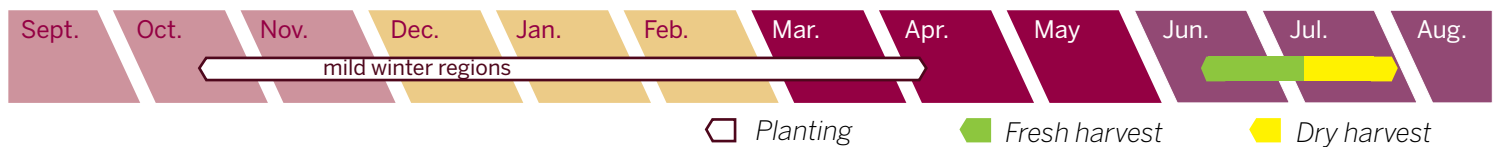


# SHALLOTS

Due to the varietal diversity of shallots, there are many different bulb shapes and colours and planting and harvesting can be staggered. There are two main categories: the grey shallot and the Jersey type (or pink shallot).

## The Jersey type

### From planting to harvest



### JERMOR

- Hardy, Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Long
- Copper skin, pinkish white flesh
- Early
- Very high yielding

### LONGOR

- Free of OYDV virus
- Very long
- Copper skin, purplish pink flesh
- Semi-early
- Very high yielding
- Good shelf-life

### MIKOR

- Hardy, Regenerated OYDV virus-free variety
- Semi-long
- Coppery pink skin, pinkish white flesh
- Late
- Very high yielding
- Good shelf-life



## Grey shallot

### From planting to harvest



### GRISELLE

- Free of OYDV virus
- Long tear-drop shaped bulb
- Thick grey skin, purplish white flesh
- Early
- Average storage time



# ONIONS

There are many varieties of onions in all shapes and colours on the market. They serve as both a vegetable and a condiment.

## From planting to harvest



### BRUNSWICK

- Hardy
- Large red slightly flattened bulb
- Late
- Very good shelf-life



### WHITE EBENEZER SILVERMOON

- Early maturing, early produce
- Large white round bulb
- Hardy
- Average shelf-life



### JAUNE PAILLE

- Large yellow flat bulb
- High yielding
- Good shelf-life



### STUTTGARTER

- Large yellow slightly flattened bulb
- Very high yielding
- Good shelf-life



### STURON

- Yellow round bulb
- Late, bolt-resistant
- High yielding
